The Carbon Offset Process

1. We work with the charter broker and captain to identify the fuel consumption of the charter.

4. We issue a personalised certificate stating the tonnes of carbon emissions offset, the emissions activities and the project selected to complete the transaction.



2. We calculate the greenhouse gas emissions associated with the identified fuel and other charter activities (as appropriate).




3. We complete the carbon offset by supporting a carefully selected, high-quality carbon reduction project. All projects adulated by of one of four International Carbon Registries.



At less than €0.05 per litre (2024) the cost to offset your charter is modest.

Indicative fuel consumption per charter week



Depending on the yacht, our data suggests that a typical 7-day charter on a 50-metre yacht may consume around 15,000 litres of fuel, which will cost no more than 6600 to carbon offset (15,000| x 60.04 = 6600).

We also offer an optional charity donation of €/\$/£1 per tonne of carbon offset to support marine-focused environmental charities. See our website for more details.
